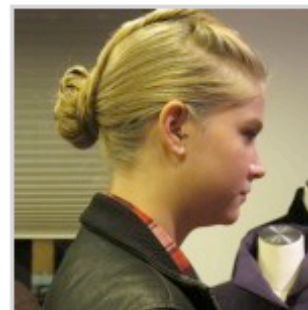
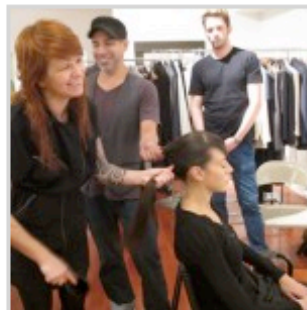
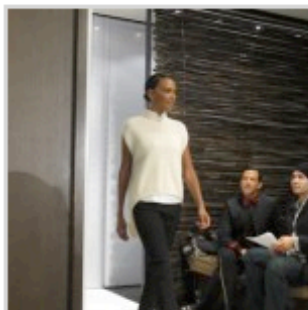


## Spring 2011 Fashion: Blanc de Chine
